An additional form for each applicant should be completed. If under the age of 18 a waiver, which can be obtained from the Hon Secretary, signed by a parent or legal guardian, must accompany this application. Reduced subscription rates are payable for anyone whilst unemployed or in full time education. Copies of a UB40 or details of college/course attended should accompany this form.

An option is also available to join the Cerberus Mountaineering Group which is affiliated to the British Mountaineering Council. To climb in Fairy Cave Quarry at any time you must include this option. There are a number of other benefits including civil liability insurance cover for walking, mountaineering and climbing activities, equipment discounts, access to climbing huts, reduced rate subscription to High magazine etc. Members of the Group also receive a copy of 'Summit', the high quality glossy magazine for BMC members.. There is a further option to upgrade to full BMC membership at a very favourable discounted rate.

A large chunk of the subscription is to maintain the clubs civil liability insurance cover. This is calculated on a per member basis. If you belong to another club that provides cover under the same scheme, or has adequate alternative cover, you may be eligible for a discount on the subscription. Contact the Secretary to discuss this.

Provisional membership is available to individuals / guests wishing to attend club trips on a trial basis. Membership gives full civil liability insurance cover for caving activities and is valid for three months. Additional benefits are only available upon election to full membership which is possible at the end of the three months, or before upon payment of the balance of the normal annual subscription.
